

Government-In-Action Youth Tour

Each year, Lamar Electric Cooperative selects two high school students to attend an all-expenses-paid tour of Washington, D.C., which includes visiting the U.S. Capitol and meeting members of Congress. Eligible students must be in 10th, 11th or 12th grade and live full time in a residence served by Lamar Electric Cooperative or attend one of the four high schools served by the co-op: Prairiland, Roxton, Detroit and Faith Christian. Home-schooled students served by Lamar Electric Cooperative are also eligible. Applications must be complete with a three-page typed essay. The essay prompt is **“Tell us about circumstances where you have demonstrated your leadership skills.”** The essay must be submitted to Lamar Electric Cooperative no later than 5 p.m. on February 8, 2019.
